

VINO DE EYZAGUIRRE (EZ-GARY)

Packaged as it was 100 years ago, when Franciscan monks discovered that burlap sacks protected precious bottles from breakage during their bumpy trips by horse-drawn cart.

Vino de Eyzaguirre is produced from the vineyards at Viña San Jorge in the prestigious Colchagua Valley, renowned for its near-perfect climate for growing grapes, and for wines of exceptional quality.



CABERNET SAUVIGNON

APPELLATION

Colchagua Valley

YIELD

5-6 tons per acre

WINEMAKER'S NOTES

Dark, violet red. Aromatic profile features fresh and dried cherry plus dried plum, with intriguing notes of dark chocolate and mint. On the palate, the wine is rich, well balanced and approachable with a long, smooth finish. Recommended food pairings: grilled or roasted meats, and full-flavored dishes with complex sauces.



MERLOT

APPELLATION

Colchagua Valley

YIELD

5 tons per acre

WINEMAKER'S NOTES

Deep garnet red. An expressive nose shows fresh red fruits like plums and cherries, accompanied by soft, delicious vanilla and tobacco notes. On the palate it is fresh, with ripe, soft tannins leading a pleasant, slightly sweet finish.



SYRAH

APPELLATION

Colchagua Valley

YIELD

5-6 tons per acre

WINEMAKER'S NOTES

Intense ruby red color, with complex notes of wild strawberry marmalade, pepper, tobacco and vanilla. Mature tannins create a well-rounded palate with a medium-bodied and pleasant finish.
